TAX COLLECTION – Collection of property tax payment is by mail only. Please make check payable to: **TOWN OF BRILLION**. Send your property tax payment to Treasurer, PO Box 216, Forest Junction, WI 54123. **PLEASE INCLUDE DOG LICENSE PAYMENT WITH THE FIRST INSTALLMENT.** If you pay your taxes with an escrow check for more than the tax bill amount, a refund check will be mailed to you after the next monthly town board meeting.

LOTTERY CREDIT – Owners of a home who used the home as their primary residence on January 1, 2016 are eligible for the Wisconsin Lottery and Gaming Credit. If you are not currently receiving the credit on your tax bill please contact Sharon Ott, Treasurer, to complete a Lottery and Gaming Credit form. The Lottery and Gaming Credit form must be completed and returned to the treasurer by January 31, 2017 to be eligible to receive a credit for 2016 tax year.

BUILDING PERMIT/BUILDING INSPECTOR – A Building Permit/Inspection is required on new homes and general remodeling over \$2,500 in value and must be obtained before work begins. Contact PAUL BIRSCHBACH, Birschbach Inspection Service, LLC. Paul's office is located at 18 W. Main St. Suite L, Chilton. Phone 920-849-9274, Fax 920-849-9289, email binspector@frontier.com. LAND-USE PERMIT – Land-Use Permits are required from Calumet County for new homes, additions or other structures and must be obtained before work begins. Contact Calumet County Planning, Zoning and Land Information Department, 206 Court Street, Chilton. 920-849-1442 or 920-989-2700. Please call ahead.

ACCESS ORDINANCE 2002-2 – Reminder that a permit is required before starting construction or reconstruction of a driveway. This shall include the blacktopping of approaches to driveways. The cost of a Concrete Access Driveway Permit is \$50 per foot of concrete. The cost of a Blacktop Access Driveway Permit is \$10.00. The fine for not obtaining a permit is \$20.00, along with a \$50.00 per foot fee for the new driveway access. Applications for driveway permits shall be obtained from the road supervisor at the Town of Brillion Municipal Building or by calling 920-875-0175 or 920-989-1602.

DITCH ORDINANCE 2005-05 - Any property owner in the Town of Brillion who has property which abuts any ditch, water course, or other earthen structure, shall be responsible to control activities upon and maintain the owned property in such a manner as to not cause or contribute to obstructions in the ditch, water course or other earthen structure which would restrict, block or prohibit the free, open and continuous flow of water through the ditch, water course or other earthen structure. DOG LICENSE – Issued by Sharon Ott, Treasurer, PO Box 216, Forest Junction, WI 54123. Dogs in the State of Wisconsin over the age of 5 months are required by law to be licensed before April 1st of each year. Please include the payment of the dog license when paying the first installment of your property tax. Make checks payable to **TOWN OF BRILLION**. A **CERTIFICATE OF RABIES VACCINATION IS REQUIRED. INCLUDE COPY OF RABIES CERTIFICATE WITH PAYMENT**, along with a self-addressed stamped envelope for return of receipt of payment, if desired. Dog license fees are \$3.00 for neutered male or spayed female, and \$8.00 for unaltered dogs. All dogs need to be licensed by April 1st. A late fee of \$5.00 per dog will be charged if paid after April 1st. Residents not willing to license their dog(s) will be referred to the Calumet County District Attorney.

FOREST JUNCTION SANITARY DISTRICT WINTER PARKING BAN – is in effect from November 15th to April 1st.

WINTER SAFETY - Residents please shovel snow away from your mailbox and “flag” the mailbox so snowplow drivers are aware of the mailbox. The town is not responsible for boxes hit by the snowplow; mailboxes are located in the town right-of-way. Also, shovel snow away from fire hydrants if needed.

For public safety concerns please do not push snow from a private driveway into the roadway or into the road ditches. This violates Wisconsin Statutes 88.01, 86.07, 346.94 or 941.30.

SUMMER LAWN MAINTENANCE - The Town Board encourages residents to maintain their yards. Please keep in mind that noxious weeds are in violation of Calumet County Ordinance.

Trash containers delivered to your residence are 90 gallons at the cost of \$140.00 per year. To order a new container, or upgrade to a 90 gallon container, contact the clerk at 920-756-5363.

Trash/recycling containers should be removed from the roadside as soon as possible to avoid damage to the containers. If at any time your trash and/or recycling are NOT picked up on the regularly scheduled day, call Advanced Disposal Customer Service at 920-458-6030.

SINGLE-STREAM RECYCLING has been in effect for a year now with great results. Recycling volume is up. For more information on recycling please visit the Town of Brillion’s website at www.townofbrillion.com. The cost of each recycling cart is \$18.00 per year and will

be reflected on your property tax bill as “Other Charge”. If you would like to order an additional recycling cart at \$18.00 please contact the clerk at 920-756-5363.

It is illegal for anyone to put electronics, tires, hazardous waste such as TV’s, computers, printers, etc., in the trash. Advanced Disposal’s recycling trucks are equipped with cameras and you will be billed accordingly if improper recycling is documented.

Other recycling options include – free disposal of most electronics and appliances at Norsec Computer Recyclers, LLC, www.recyclegreenbay.com, located at 809 Prosper St, DePere, WI 54115, (920) 660-8181.

Bulky items can be taken to Hickory Hills Landfill – W3105 Schneider Road, Hilbert, (920) 853-8553. \$25.00 charge for appliances, they do not accept electronics. \$69.00 per ton with a \$40.00 minimum charge.

Purchase a “Sticker” through the Town of Brillion and we arrange pickup of your bulky item through Advanced Disposal. \$50.00 for the first bulky item and \$25.00 per item after the first item.
